The Authors reported that the TSS values obtained for sample T7 were the highest but in this section of the manuscript they reported two values: 67.00 and 67.66 degrees Brix. Which of these values is correct?</li><li>2. Authors describing data placed in tables or figures should also make such a note in the section of the manuscript where they are discussed, e.g. (table 2).</li><li>3. In describing the data obtained for pH, the Authors noted that these values decreased with storage time. Why? Please comment briefly in the text of the manuscript.</li><li>4. When making sensory evaluations of the samples tested, did the evaluators indicate the reason for the low rating of sample T1 with regard to smell and taste?</li><li>5. Did the tested samples change color after their storage period? Were they cloudy? Are the authors able to answer this question?</li><li>6. The tables should be arranged by the Authors in the order in which the results are discussed.</li></ol>	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The manuscript should be checked for word errors, e.g. flavonoids instead of "flavinoids" or antioxidants instead of "antioxidents". There were also words with capital letters in the middle of sentences or clusters of words.</li><li>2. In the Reference section, Authors should write the first segment of the Latin plant's name in capital letters. Besides, match the names of journals with the requirements of the journal (abbreviations or full names).</li></ol>
