Besides, "Low-cost" may be better changed to "low-cost". 2. Duplicated keywords (same as the paper title) should be re-chosen. 3. What is "lakh hectares"? 4. Please unify the use of "kg ha⁻¹" and "kg/ha". Similarly with other units such as "kg/ha mm". 5. Please explain "rabi" season to the international readers. 6. All acronym names must be defined when first appear, such as EC, S Ed., CD. 7. Please number all equations listed in the text. 8. Is WUE = WP? 9. The correct form is "et al.", not "et al". 10. Table caption should be on top the table. 11. Tables 1 and 2 have not been referred to in the text. 12. Add footnote for "a to f" in Tables 1 and 2. Besides, what is the row listed as I, S, lxS, Sxl? 13. Add units used for yield, WUE, cost and return values in captions of Tables 1, 2, and 3. 14. Table 3 and Figure 3 (Figures 1 and 2 not used) use the same data. Please choose one form (either table or figure) to display the same data. 15. Please unify the use of "B:c ratio", "B: C ratio". Why not just use the prevalent "B/C ratio" instead. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. As per the editorial comment, a change has been made from "in Groundnut" to "for groundnut" and "Low-cost" to "low-cost". 2. As per the editorial comment, it is revised as cost reduction technology 3. lakh hectares is revised to m ha (million hectares) as per the norms 4. As per the editorial comment, it is unified as "kg/ha" and similarly "kg/ha mm" is unified as "kg/ha.mm" 5. The ICAR is the authority to fix the agricultural curriculum and research in India. They classified agricultural cropping seasons namely <i>kharif</i> (June- July to September), <i>rabi</i> (October-November to January-February), and <i>zaid / summer</i> (February-March to May-June) depending on the climatic requirement of crops. Groundnut is cultivated during January and so, the crop is mentioned in the "rabi" season. "rabi" season was internationally considered as Spring season 6.
