Authors could include the following reference: Olayiwola et al., The antidiabetic potential of <i>Jatropha tanjorensis</i> leaves, Niger J Nat Prod Med Volume 8, Pages 55 – 58.2. Many reported results in Table 1 and Table 2 have the same numbers and it seems like reported numbers are too good to be true.3. Figures 3, 4 and 5 needs to be replaced.4. Authors could conduct more experiments to show the efficacy of the extracts. For eg., experiments suggested in this journal Y.Mizushima 1996, SCREENING TEST FOR ANTIRHEUMATIC DRUGS.5. Authors have not explained the reason behind including Ibuprofen and Sulfasalazine together in the studies. They need to elaborate the details in "discussion" or "Introduction" sections.6. Experimental design is seriously flawed. Authors should have included a group of rats with only Ibuprofen (5mg/kg/day) and <i>J.tanjorensis</i> extracts at different doses.
