<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	This paper analyses internal audit and internal control in the Kumasi Office of GHA. Its novelty consists in the adoption of the staff perspective. The paper is interesting and the methodology is clearly described. The results are also presented in a clear way. However, in my opinion, the theoretical part of the paper should be improved. I suggest a better review of literature, which is quite poor now. This is also confirmed by the list of references, which should contain a higher number of international journal articles focused on internal audit and internal control.	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	There are some typos that must be correct. For example, "The sample had 66% males and 34% less" must be corrected ("less" is surely wrong: is it "female"?). Proofreading is recommended.
