Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>This paper shows how the academic performance of Bhutanese students varies with extracurricular activities. The content seems to be very meaningful. However, it is conceivable that the impact will change depending on the educational system and the ratio of extracurricular activities and school life in a day. From the perspective of people in other countries, there are opinions that extracurricular activities put pressure on sleep time and leave no time for school homework. There is also the issue of cost. In the case of this paper, if we are considering submitting it to an international journal, I think it would be better to describe whether or not such an influence can be ignored. Below are the points I noticed in the current manuscript, so please refer to them for revision.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - It is better to recheck and correct the English text, including the title. Isn't "under" wrong in "under Samdrup Jongkhar"? When writing about previous reports, the method of writing the author's name is strange. For example, "(Zaman, 2017) notes" in P2L3 should be corrected. - Wouldn't it be better to show whether there is no change depending on the time and type of extracurricular activities? - I don't know if extracurricular activities are taking up too much time to do other things (for example, can I show how I spend my 24 hours?). - There was a grade, but there is also a difference in the educational system from other countries, so I don't understand how old they are and how long they stay in school. 	
Minor REVISION comments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Some of the abbreviations in the table are unclear. There are things that can be imagined, but it is better to state proper attribution. - Is it possible that extracurricular activities have a secondary effect? For example, meeting friends, having fun, or exchanging information. - It would be better to write in detail how to take the questionnaire. It seems that the content of the answer may change depending on the age and the listening method. 	
Optional/General comments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Isn't the title DISCUSSION, CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATION unnecessary? Or it's better to separate them.
