The cause of most cases of Auto Immune Hepatitis (AIH) is not clear; but is thought to be a mixture of autoimmunity, environmental triggers, and genetic predisposition. However, the manuscript presents hepatitis A as a possible trigger factor for AIH development. The general interest and significance of the study are appropriate to the level of the journal.	
Minor REVISION comments	There is a need to thoughtfully proof-read and correct the manuscript. Figures (histology) have no links in the text. Formatting of the text and figures require correction according to the journal's requirements is needed, too.
