Compulsory REVISION comments	The authors should add other relevant studies on the attitudes of medical students or health care workers toward vaccination to 1.4. Vaccination against COVID-19 to better align the study with the context and highlight the value of this paper. Because the authors explore medical students' attitudes toward vaccination, 1.4 has no relevant studies that coincide with it. It may detract from the study's primary purpose.	
Minor REVISION comments	In 4. Discussion , the authors cite others who argue that "Medical students are at increased risk to develop the COVID-19 infections and this can lead to a significant collapse in the health care system." I am afraid that this view is too radical. This view is not problematic if medical students are replaced with health care workers. Still, medical students are divided into categories, with some medical students interning in hospitals and others studying in medical schools, the latter perhaps not yet exposed to patients. Therefore, the authors need to elaborate on which kind of medical students are here and not express them in general terms.
