It has many flaws. The authors need major revisions.

1) The paper introduces several kinds of drugs without explanation. The authors should explain drugs, such as heroin, fencidil, yaba, opium, marijuana, etc, on their component and effects.

2) In the section of Review of the literature, the authors introduce previous studies as like itemization. The author has to explain literature as like a story.

3) lakh is an Indian word. It should be written as hundred thousands.

4) The authors have to explain how they gained data of two case studies and 50 respondents for questionnaire survey.

5) I think Figure 1 and 2 are the results of questions with only one answer option with pie charts. This is Okay. However, Figure 3 and 4 may be the results of questions with multiple answer choices. If so, the authors cannot present the result by pie charts! That is because the total respondents cannot be summarizes as 100%. They have to present the result by multiple bar charts. Anyway, the authors have to show the questionnaires in the text.

6) section number 5.2 for conclusion and 5.1 for recommendation are wrong. They should be 4 and 5.

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
