The authors must correct the following flaws prior to paper acceptance:

1. Add "India" in the paper title.
2. Acronym names such as PUC should be defined when first appear.
3. All keywords duplicate the same as in the paper title. Other selections should be re-chosen.
4. Please unify the use of "%", "percent" or "pre cent". Always leave a space between number and %.
5. Only the authors' last names must be used in citing literature in the text.
6. The number of farmers (1, 67,041) is very odd.
7. What is "Spps" software? Is it "SPSS"? By the way, statistical tests such as "Chi-square", "Yates' correction for continuity" and "SPSS", which are not being used in this study, should not be even mentioned in the methodology section.
8. Unify the use of "table" and "Table".
9. There is no such word as "cosmopliteness".
10. Include initials for the authors' first name in the reference list.

Use "and" instead of "&" throughout the entire text.
