<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	The authors mentioned that this is the first revision about the subject at their Hospital. Always is important to know what is happening with each medical problem to can perform the guidelines for the treatment options and not only act based in foreing statistics. This statistics should be taking in account to compare with the own statistics to try to improve the treatments. Thus, is very important the effort of the authors to analize a very important problem like peri and postpartum hysterectomy. They have found some risk factors in the population studied that allow improve the treatments and set up this factors. There are something not very clear because there was a high number of hysterectomies in patients with early pregnancy loss (8)(??) and in other table they show only 3 cases of pregnancies of 37 week's of gestational age. This is not clear, because is possible to think that the early pregnancy losses were infected as a cause of the haemorrage and hysterectomy and this is not specified in the study.
