Here I have several minor comments.</p> <p>(1) The major issue is about the language, There are massive minor errors in English throughout the manuscript, including punctuation, tense, and upper/lower case, etc. For example, in the title, there should be a space between "Utilization" and "(HcRU)". The "U.S" should be "U.S."</p> <p>(2) I understand that the author divided women by the menopause age 50, which is of clinical importance. However, a more detailed division (set up more groups according to age) will make your results more impactful.</p>
