<b><u>Compulsory</u></b> REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Since the parameters in the study affected significantly are the residual symptoms of the patients, it would be advisable to mention the incidence and prevalence of the symptomatic complaints of the patients.</li> <li>As per the study design mentioned in the manuscript, both the physician and patients have been blinded, and only a nurse who does not participate in the study is aware of the patients receiving PRP application, then kindly clarify who applies the PRP intraoperatively, given that it is a double blinded trial.</li> <li>Since the parameter in the study showing significant difference is a subjective one, can the authors provide an objective standard of measurement, like the time taken for the septal perforation to heal.</li> </ol>	
<b><u>Minor</u></b> REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>'Nasal septal perforation of the cartilaginous and/or bony nasal septum is an anatomical defect. is the majority of cases have asymptomatic perforation; nonetheless, symptomatic cases have recurrent nasal crusting, epistaxis, whistling, dryness, headache, and nasal obstruction.' The sentence in the discussion requires grammatical correction</li> </ol>	
<b><u>Optional/General</u></b> comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Provide images or diagrams of the surgical procedure</li> <li>Mention about the site from which the cartilage is harvested for closure of the perforation.</li> </ol>
