<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	The paper is generally well written. The table on the polymorphisms noted in the study is clear. However, the origin of the frequency of the A allele indicated below the table as 71(48.63%) and 75(51.31%) is not clear. Perhaps, a table showing the numbers from which the calculations were made would be helpful. Some statements could use a reference for confirmation. For example, "Heritability is responsible for 40-60% of the population's variability in developing an addiction." The sentence COMPT gene realte to different... apparently uses the spelling "realte" that could be replaced by "associated with." I was not able to find a full length definition for "KNPs." If this is not present, it should be added. Lastly there is a discussion of practitioners of neuropsychology in that area of the world. I do not see how this particular discussion relates to the purpose of the study, namely the association of genetic polymorphisms with various forms of addiction.
