The fundamental basis of cryptocurrency generation seems to be the "mine". This involves solving mathematical puzzles that do not relate to economic growth as a whole & appear to be arbitrary. The present wild swings in cryptocurrency values may reflect this arbitrary quality. The lessons of the South Sea & Mississippi Bubbles, "Tulip mania" & John Law & need to be considered in this document. Currency generation unrelated to economic development should, perhaps, be avoided.
