Recheck all the keywords.</p> <p>Introduction- 'but still many cotton growers committed suicides' what is the source cite the source. (Shwetha <i>et al.</i> (2022)) should be before the last line of introduction.</p> <p>Method- Reframe the first line according to your title of the article. Two blocks are mentioned in material and method but in abstract only one block. Methodology should be very clear. Why ranking scale is used justify. 'highest area under cotton crop' cite the source. Table 1 If it is secondary data cite the source properly.</p> <p>Result and Discussion- Third line it should be table 2 not table 1.</p> <p>References- Recheck according to Journal's instruction .</p>	
Minor REVISION comments	<p>Introduction- COCP year is missing.</p> <p>Method- first sentence 'carried on' should be 'carried out'.</p> <p>Result and discussion- Recheck the grammar and paragraph. If required write in two or three paragraphs citing the source accordingly rather giving all the sources at the end.</p> <p>Table 3 – Sl.no 5. Spelling of cost.</p>	
Optional/General comments	<p>Result and discussion- No need to give same data again and again i.e. Table 2 and figure 1 and Table 3 and figure 2. Overall Proof reading required, cite more sources and put appropriately wherever necessary.</p>
