Compulsory REVISION comments	The authors should substitute 'attitude' in the title with 'practices'. The source of the sample size determination formula should be cited. The sampling method said to have been used in the study is wrongly explained. The Section C has no attitude questions and should be changed to practices in the instrument used. The authors should quote the number of the ethical clearance certificate obtained for the work. There was no sub-section on data analyses in the methods section. This should be provided. How the level of awareness and 'attitudes' were measured were not captured in the methods section by the authors. They should be provided. The authors kept on repeating the results in the discussion section. This is not proper. The discussion section is for the discussion of the results and not for its repetition. The references were good and consistent. The questionnaire should be attached after the reference section.
