Secondly a delayed presentation by around 10 hours cannot be considered as late intervention Thirdly, no proper comparison has been made regarding the differences in the management of the two cases. Fourthly the abstract needs revision where the clinical findings have not been mentioned explicitly An inference on need for urethral injury has been made in the abstract without doing so in the main manuscript.
