The fundus findings should at a minimum include whether there was only one haemorrhage or multiple haemorrhages, and whether there were no findings of tuberculous uveitis, such as retinal vascular occlusion. The basis for the diagnosis of tuberculous meningitis and whether there were no tuberculous lesions in other parts of the body should also be described.
