

Editor's Comment:

In this clinical research study an attempt is made to evaluate transposition of great arteries using computed tomography.

To my opinion both reviewers raise important issues related to the quality of the manuscript as well as the setup of the clinical research itself:

1/ It is clear that the manuscript needs proper language check by a professional

2/ The patient sample size is not acceptable, being quite small. More cases are needed

3/ There are issues with terminology and methodology and the authors are urged to have a discussion with paediatric cardiologist or a surgeon

4/ Literature should be enriched with recent publications

5/ Exposing newborns to CT/radiation is an issue that has to be addressed properly

My editorial opinion is that the authors should ask a pediatric congenital transposition expert for advice, proceed to the corrections as proposed by the referees and resubmit the paper in a revised form.
