Please, decrypt TVB-N, SD, RTD, OD and RTD when they are mentioned for the first time in the abstract.</p> <p>The aim of the study is not marked enough clearly. It would be better not to start the aim from the word "however".</p> <p>In the description of the drying methods 1 and 2, it seems important to mention the total time of the drying procedures.</p> <p>In the paragraph "Proximate Composition Analysis", describing the core of the method in few phrases will be appreciated by the readers.</p> <p>In "result and discussion", the authors did not explain why to their knowledge protein, ash and lipid content was considerably lower in smoke dried samples? Because of the higher moisture content?</p>
