Minor REVISION comments		
Optional/General comments	Physicians have to be aware of typical clinical presentations, but also must be aware that actinomycosis may mimic the malignancy process in various anatomical sites. Bacterial cultures and pathology are the cornerstones of diagnosis and require particular attention to prevent misdiagnosis. Surgery should be discussed in complicated cases.
