I recommend the authors improve this aspect.</p> <p><b>Case Report:</b></p> <p>1. Images should be placed after the information is given about them or once they are mentioned.</p> <p><b>Discussion:</b></p> <p>1. The first time that abbreviations are used, they should be stated with their meaning, and then the abbreviations should be placed between parentheses, except for those that are universally known. In this manuscript, the abbreviations SMA and SMV are used without first stating their meaning.</p> <p><b>References:</b></p> <p>The references should be reviewed carefully to correct some inaccuracies.
