Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>The authors present a case report of a gastric Schwanoma resected by laparoscopy. Although the case is interesting, the manuscript has several misleading information. First, it is debatable to do a laparoscopic approach to such a large GIST tumor (this was the initial diagnosis). The authors never discussed it. Second, if the diagnosis was a GIST why the authors performed a lymphadenectomy if GIST do not metastasize to lymph nodes? Or did the authors change their mind of the diagnosis? At what point and why? Third, the final diagnosis needs an extensive immunohistochemical analysis that was not provided.</p> <p>Other comments: Language needs extensive revision.</p>
