Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>This paper examines the impact of inflation targeting policy adoption on inflation and inflation volatility in Ghana from 1985 through 2014. The paper is deal with an interesting and recent issue and is also important from a policy perspective. However, the paper needs significant revision before its publication. The following comments demonstrate why this paper needs significant revision.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Mention the JEL classification code. 2) The manuscript is subject to significant language issues including grammatical errors. Many sentences are weak and too long that compromising with clarity and precision of the sentences. Authors need to rewrite some of the sentences in order to bring preciseness to it. Further, I suggest authors follow the standard papers bit by bit to write systematically. 3) Mention briefly how this paper is organized in the last paragraph of the introduction section. 4) The authors need to present a section with the theoretical background. 5) This study has not addressed the recent development of literature that was published after 2015. Authors should address the recent papers that have been published in various journals. 6) Most literature accentuates that inflation is the cause of either the demand factor or the supply factor. Authors can address this issue by including demand and supply-related variables in the model. 7) The central bank of each country makes available monthly and quarterly inflation data. However, this study used annual data and then converted it into quarterly data. 8) Mark section and subsection with numeric properly (as per the journal needs).
