<u>Compulsory</u> REVISION comments	The main finding consists in a wide discrepancy in the morbidity of CML in Nigeria, when compared with that in the UK. Of note is an incidence of the disease in 1-2 cases per 100,000 worldwide. Although little is known about the aetiology of the tumor, radiation might be more significant in Europe! Marked differences have been noted in the access to TKI. However, this does not affect the wide differences related to the morbidity by localization.	
<u>Minor</u> REVISION comments	Though difficult to identify, more significant factors should be searched to justify the differences between Europe and Nigeria, regarding the incidence of CGL. Introduction of cytogenetic studies for routine deems necessary.
