General information of the patient may be restricted to what is required. A detailed family history with so much elaborated father's and brother's illness which is not relevant. Is not required. Many grammatical errors, spelling mistakes and repetitions noticed (some are highlighted).</p> <p>Author may kindly tabulate the reports of the patient and avoid the scanned copies.</p> <p>Discussion may be done by adding more evidences from the recent studies which are relevant.</p> <p>Conclusion – may be reframed to make it more specific and fulfil the aim of the case study. Also reframing of the sentences required for meaningful inferences.</p> <p>References- both in-text and in the end may be cited according to the Vancouver style of referencing or journal guidelines. Author may kindly refer to this.</p>
