Please use both reliable and representative theories especially aimed for explaining the relationship between pragmatics, literary devices, and discourse analysis;</li><li>2. Farefari oral libation text should be highlighted and positioned as the research's primary concept;</li><li>3. The three types of libation text, namely: (1) community based libation; (2) clan based libation; and (3) ancestral based libation; should first be discussed under conceptual framework, thus explained furthermore in the analysis segment;</li><li>4. Author should provide one valid method of translating the text's source language into target language;</li><li>5. Unfamiliar use of numbers are found in some part of the analysis;</li><li>6. Unless structuralism theory is used, author should only limit this research on analyzing the text's formulaic expressions.</li></ol>
