Minor REVISION comments	Discussion: Before management more informative is named mechanisms of resistance. Possible mechanisms mediating resistant state are: patient's compliance, drug malabsorption but + rapid drug metabolism, antidrug antibodies, impaired intrathyroidal accumulation and action and predominant elevation of T3 than T4. And after that describe management. Useful statement to the text is.....The measurement of the drug levels or anti-drug antibodies may be undertaken but these tests are not available for routine clinical use.	
Optional/General comments	For absolutely precision it would be helpful to write world common causes of thyrotoxicosis in abstract (because exists other rarest such as iodine induced (amiodarone), HCG, thyroid resistance, TSH secreting tumor ect.
