

### **Editor's Comment:**

"Applications of Genetic Distances on Blood-group Gene Frequencies and their Statistical Genetic Similarities", although initially written in an "aerial" and rather careless way, it became a well-written and organized manuscript, mainly due to the good work of the reviewers .

The problem at this stage is that it does not add anything relevant to scientific knowledge, either from a theoretical or practical point of view, which jeopardizes its interest even as a review article.

In fact, the authors' conclusions are mere suggestions weakly based on the results obtained, which should be presented very cautiously, and much more thoughtful.

Therefore, I cannot recommend the publication of this manuscript.

I will be able to re-examine this article if the authors heed the above remark and explain to me the meaning of expressions such as:

For the Minkowski and Euclidean distances, it was found that the **correlations** between Eakimo and Korea has the smallest distance (line 13 of the Discussion and Results).

In addition, English needs a thorough grammatical revision. Also note that there are proper names starting with a lowercase letter.
