<p>Authors made some minor editing improvements in their text but however they did not followed recommendation about the statistical analysis. It is not possible to claim that i.e. mosquitoes were less abundant in week "X" than in week "Y", if there is not a statical comparison between the studied periods or boxes. Although there is interesting information, there is a lack of statistical basis on this manuscript. Further, some other highlighted points were not followed (i.e. why dataset was pooled, or how authors managed to collect adult females mosquitos or clarify percentage in table captures) or did not clarified properly in comments' answers. Therefore, I regret to inform you that I cannot recommend the further publication of the certain article as it does not follow basic statistical approaches</p>	<p>The statistical error in this study has been addressed as suggested, it was actually an omission.</p> <p>Sorry, I have been very busy lately but very glad you insisted on this correction which I have effected</p>
