Minor REVISION comments	1. It could have been nice to state the causes of AKI in those with normal G6PD. 2. WBC and neutrophils were statistically significant in those with Aki. You claimed in your discussion that this may have been because of infection. It will be nice to state urinalysis result and culture if the were done. 3. Other minor correction as stated in the main text.
