The internal text citations in the intro are poorly done and unacceptable in standard research. The theories underpinning the paper were not perfectly digested into the work. The conclusion is weak, not strongly linked from a critical discussion (subtitle) which is obviously missing.</p> <p>I am afraid the author(s) is/are the same with Ms_ARJASS_92767. Same writing technique, same expressions and same technical blunders. This paper requires major revision in terms of structure and logic of presentation. A subtitle of Dissuasion should be included before conclusion.</p>
