Minor REVISION comments	<p>This article has a descriptive nature based simple on literature review; however, it makes a good systematization of the mining activity in Ghana, its history, and its complex effects. I would suggest to delete the section "concepts and definitions"...because it is not really relevant to present those concepts in a previous section. Or delete or pass its contents into the text, to where it may be needed to understand the overall sense.</p> <p>The conclusion could also have been more reflexive. Taking into considerations the alerts pointed by this descriptive analysis it should be relevant to include some general considerations on how priority it is to evolve the mining activity into a more sustainable development approach.</p> <p>I would also suggest to include a hierarchy in all sections.
