Please, add possible causes of increased infection in some localities.

Some authors have suggested that uncircumcised male partners are more likely to develop a potential foreskin infection and may re-infect his wife or other females upon intercourse. Also, women who have multiple male partners such as prostitutes and who resort to anal intercourse rather than the normal vaginal route are more likely to become infected and transmit the infection.
