Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>The article is relevant to understand the behavior of Chlamydia trachomatis infection, as well as to show relevant data on its prevalence, biology, genetics and consequences, being relevant because it has important implications for the understanding of the infection and for public health and specifically in the adequate care and approach to people with the infection and/or its prevention. The abstract could be structured more carefully, specifying in a better way the method, the results and the main conclusions.</p> <p>The introduction contains information that accounts for the state of the art, relevant information on Chlamydia trachomatis infection, its consequences and contextualizes the topic to be addressed in the article.</p> <p>The article presents a robust analysis of the state of the art, the literature and the understanding from the first studies to the current behavior of the infection, however it is necessary to specify the method section, it is not enough to mention the objective and very briefly the methodology used. for the collection and presentation of information.</p> <p>It is necessary to specify in the body of the article the chapter on study method, specifying the type of research, in addition to the databases consulted, the number of studies, years in which they were published, information analysis process, procedure. The specification of this chapter may help the authors to strengthen the conclusions, since the information presented in the conclusions is the same that has been repeated in various sections of the study, so it is suggested that in addition to that presented, they may include conclusions in relation to the study and not only in terms of Chlamydia trachomatis infection.</p> <p>The tables and graphs are clear and provide the necessary information to understand the importance of the study.</p> <p>Finally, I suggest strengthening the conclusions, expanding them and could specify recommendations for future studies on this topic and being more daring, specifying recommendations at the level of public health.</p>
