Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>Organisation of the manuscript need to be improved.</p> <p>Title must be changed to be more comprehensible and to have more impact for potential readers.</p> <p>recoil-rebound maneuver (3R / CPR) : are these terms known from all interested readers ? significantly promote ROSC. : explain ROSC (abbreviation ???)</p> <p>Abstract text for results is not sufficiently clear and punchy.</p> <p>Conceivably : why this adverb ?</p> <p>The end of the MS (from page 6) is difficult to follow. Subtitles are not properly placed or chosen.</p> <p>Page 6: It could be useful to shortly describe what "Heimlich's maneuver »is</p> <p>Is "The 3R/CPR: Refill-Recoil-Rebound</p> <p>« the name given by the authors to their new procedure ? It's not clear.</p> <p>Page 8. The title must be DISCUSSION. Results are expressed before. If the authors wish, they can add subtitle, but in this case, the first subtitle at the beginning of the Discussion is lacking.</p>	
Minor REVISION comments	<p>whether fibrillated due to.... fibrillation ????</p> <p>First sentence of introduction. See grammatical veracity (capitals, coma etc...)</p> <p>In-hospitals (IHCA) or Out-of-hospitals (OHCA) add cardiac arrests</p> <p>Add signification of the abbreviation DC (page 4) and ECMO (page 5) OHCA & IHCA (page6) before their first occurrence</p> <p>Page 6, instead of the title METHODS, group the 2 paragraphs and indicate as subtitle A NEW METHOD, or A NEW PROPOSED PROTOCOLE</p>	
Optional/General comments	The authors propose a new protocole for management SCA. Their method combines manual cardiac massage and mechanical circulatory flow restoration (CFR).
