<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	<p>1. The English need improvement since there are some grammatical and syntax errors in the manuscript. For example, the words "Covid-19 infection" may be as "The COVID-19 infection"; "development of" as "the development of"; "the damage" as "damage"; "fatal symptom" as "a fatal symptom"; "of Covid-19" as "of the COVID-19"; "Development" as "The development"; "pandemic" as "the pandemic"; "Yet quick" as "Yet the quick"; "in propagation" as "in the propagation"; "healing" as "the healing"; "active" as "an active"; "as adrenal" as "as the adrenal"; "reproductive" as "the reproductive"; "The nature" as "Nature"; "for good" as "for a good"; "killer of" as "killer in"; "the major" as "to the major"; "in 19th" as "in the 19th"; "relationship of" as "relationship between"; "vaccination" as "the vaccination"; "like viral" as "like a viral"; "silence TET-1" as "silence the TET-1"; "heal wound" as "heal a wound"; "a preparation" as "preparation"; "the normal" as "normal". The grammar mistakes which are not mentioned here are also to be checked and corrected properly.</p> <p>2. There are some typing mistakes as well, and authors are advised to carefully proof-read the text. For example, the words "symptom of" may be as "symptoms of"; "Covid-19" as "COVID-19"; "to develop" as "to developing"; "Key words" as "Keywords"; "world-wide" as "worldwide"; "gathering" as "gatherings"; "restriction to" as "restrictions to"; "damages to" as "damage to"; "of wound" as "of wounds"; "vise versa" as "vice versa"; "heal wound" as "heal wounds"; "metabolism" as "metabolisms"; "Evidently" as "Evidently,"; "No body" as "Nobody"; "chemo-surveillance" as "chemo surveillance"; "cell killing" as "cell-killing"; "build up" as "build-up". The typos not mentioned here are also to be checked and corrected properly.</p> <p>3. The authors may improve the discussion of their work by focusing on the present findings and introducing data from other authors who also worked with the same or other studies with recent references.</p> <p>4. In conclusion, the authors may be included the limitation of the present review for a better understanding of the manuscript.</p>	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	<p>1. Make a word abbreviated in the article that is repeated at least three times in the text, not all words need to be abbreviated.</p> <p>2. The literature search should be described in detail. The authors are encouraged to include the database, search engines, the keywords used to collect the information for the present review which may be included in the introduction section or separately in the materials heading since it is a review article.</p>	
<b>Optional/General</b> comments	The authors have put effort to evaluate the "The Impact of Covid-19 Pandemic on Cancer Patients". The authors describe the research undertaken with this in an organized manner, emphasizing the results obtained by them. The article needs modification for better cohesion of information to achieve the goal and the shortcomings which need to be considered. Hence, the paper can be accepted after MINOR REVISIONS are carried out.
