2. One of the reviewers requested the authors to attach the image of the histopathological examination in this manuscript; it's important and attracts more audience, but it is found that authors submitted the Figure-2: Histopathology Report instead of the images of histopathological examination.
3. Attaching Histopathology Report in the full form as figure is unwanted, apart from that the submitted report has the name of the patient, therefore attracts the possibility of ethical concerns in future, therefore the Figure-2 Histopathology Report may be avoided to present as figure, the contents of the histopathology may be included in the manuscript as one of the paragraph under one new subtitle *Histopathology Report* (Without the patient name and pathologist name) is recommended.
4. Also the figures may be re-distributed as follows:
Fig.1: External appearance of the osteosarcoma.
Fig.2: Morphology of the osteosarcoma. (CT-Scan)
Fig.3: Histopathological images of the osteosarcoma. (If any) Not the Histopathology Report
