Introduction is not elaborated and the aim is not clear. There is no any sentence about the materials and methods. Lack of Ethical Committee permission and Patient Consent Form are missed. Figs lack the description. Discussion is practically absent. Number of References is highly not enough (7) and the showed contain 2 previous century references what is not acceptable for serious scientific Journal.	
Minor REVISION comments	Grammar check is mandatory. Abbreviation usage also is mandatory and should be included.
