Minor REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> In mentioning inside references, it is suggested to follow the APA format rather than stating numeric values (see introduction). It is not essential to divide the literature into two sections: theoretical and empirical. Simply keep the literature in one section (e. g. literature review). In this section, we expect the discussion of empirical research objectives, sample data, analysis period, empirical model, research findings, and critical comparison of the empirical findings of previous literature. Hence, there is a scope for improvement in this section. It is suggested to present descriptive statistics in this research. In page 13, table 1.4, the significance level (*) associated with the coefficients is not correctly presented. For example: Incorrect: loggdp 0.506*** (0.101) Correct: loggdp 0.506* (0.101) So, please have a look at this issue. In recommendation, it is suggested that Policymakers should manage inflation. It is suggested to mention about contractionary monetary policy or issuance of government bonds could reduce the level of inflation rather than just managing it. It is suggested to follow the APA referencing style in the end section.
