<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	<p><b>In my opinion, in the present form this paper is not really an academic paper. Searching for a definition of "academic paper" I found the following:</b> "An academic paper is not a social commentary, an opinion or a "blog". An academic paper begins with a thesis - the writer of the academic paper aims to persuade readers of an idea or solution to a problem based on EVIDENCE - not personal opinion."</p> <p><b>In this paper no research questions are stated, addressed, and answered</b></p> <p><b>It does not include sufficient relevant theory, A few studies are cited, but their theses are neither explained nor discussed.</b></p> <p>Ethical requirements, including how the research was conducted, have not been fully addressed.</p>	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	<p>I did not clearly understand the meaning of some sentences: One example thereof is the following sentence: <b>Teacher with similar hopes and problems solving disposition the building teachers were displaying.</b></p> <p>In other occasions, the sentence does not follow from what has been written before; one example thereof is the following sentence: "As property taxes drive school funding, in economically depressed areas, it is no wonder schools struggle with funding and services for students. <b>It is of course no surprise that research shows socioeconomic status to be an important factor for educational achievement"</b></p> <p>Although the focus of the paper is on the concrete experience of some teachers, no data have been reported on the total number of students in the school, total number of teachers, local strategies about the pandemic and dates of their issuance, hypotheses examined by the staff regarding the management during the pandemic, and similar issues.</p>
