Compulsory REVISION comments	This work on Catunaregam spinosa; a plant with documented piscicidal activity is well thought of. Danio rerio which is popularly known as Zebra fish is currently been advocated for use in studies of vertebrates in preference to mice. This work established the toxicity of C. spinosa on the embryos' of Danio rerio, which is innovative. However the paper does not provide sufficient benefits of this research. There are no implications of this study, recommendations or what further studies are to be carried out to add value to the findings of this present study. The graph in Figure 2 is not suitable for describing this type of data as half the points are not of the slope. A chart should be used instead.	
Minor REVISION comments	The work requires comprehensive grammatical correction as the entire write-up needs a total overhaul.
