QOL questions are rather irrelevant to me unless some parameter of cardiac function is added, e.g. NT_proBNP levels or NYHA classifications or at least heart rate recovery. The authors must differentiate the type of heart failure depending on the ejection fraction.	
Minor REVISION comments	The authors should reduce some of the information when the list of items is more than 3. It becomes meaningless when 6-8 items are listed. The study should select priorities in order to communicate them to the readers.
