Contrary to that, the data on mortality and dosage should be made into a figure and not just appear in the text. For the highest concentration, show the accumulating effect on mortality over the 6 days of observations on another figure	
Minor REVISION comments	A virus is not a parasite, so denghue fever is not caused by parasites. Anopheles is a genus, not a species. Larviciding is routinely used against Aedes, including A aegypti and albopictus and all the closely related species that transmit denghue, yellow fever, chikungunya, sika-sika etc etc	
Optional/General comments	This is one of many lab studies on these photosensitizers. What we need is a semi field study. If this study is a lab study before a semifield study, it should say so
