The reference list is adequate for a case report  1. The author(s) did not state in this manuscript whether or not this patient's disease followed the same pattern as documented in the Literature. 2. The number of cases of the rare and sole finding of trisomy 5 in B-ALL is statistically few to conclude this finding is common among the older children
