Did this patient receive any chemotherapy?</b></p> <p>Would be helpful to know in the section of Follow up and outcomes- What did the patient die of? Septic shock vs hypovolemic shock vs other etiology as final cause of death.</p> <p>A labelled CT scan and intraoperative images will be helpful in defining the pathology better for the readers.</p>	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments  1. <b>Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?</b>	<p>The manuscript needs major grammatical corrections, such as long sentences with commas in Abstract should be divided into separate sentences.  <b>Certain spelling corrections- such as vomitting, assesement.</b>            Some initial letter of sentence are not upper case.</p>
