However, before publication there are some major revisions should be carried out as follows.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The manuscript has little mistakes in the the case report section 2. The title of the manuscript could be more informative as the title doesnot infer what the author wants to convey (as adenocarcinoma is a histopathological report) 3. The history is for a long term (1 year) but if it is malignant then some complications are expected 4. The Computed tomography images preoperatively doesnot show any lesion in mastoid (cuts are not available) and it shows soft tissue thickening in External auditory canal (EAC)– suggesting lesion in External auditory canal (malignancy of EAC) 5. Malignancy of EAC is more common and hence justify with preoperative otoendoscopy images or intraoperative mastoid images with histopathological slide images to add weightage to your article 6. Kindly document the post operative images or audiometry images 7. This article should be added in the category of case report <p>Thanking you</p>
