I include a reference I have found very useful for that purpose</p> <p>McCarthy, LH & K.E.H. Reilly. How to write a case report. Fam Med 2000;32(3):190-5</p> <p>Yes</p> <p>I believe some of the references are not adequate for the importance of this case; the author should review them.</p> <p>References and citations should be included in the introduction, where most of the literature review is written</p> <p>On the Case Presentation, there is no mention on the first test done to diagnose COVID-19 and neither the clinical presentation due to this infection</p> <p>The author states that there are no cases of gastroparesis after rectal cancer surgery at home or abroad. After a quick search of the medical literature, several papers addressing this issue were found. It is recommended to check this statement.</p> <p>Each figure should have a concise description of what the author wants to show. Do not assume everybody is a radiologist</p>
