Yes, I suggested an alternative title, "Monitoring land changes using remote sensing methods and spatial information system in the area of Kahrizak waste disposal center." 3. No, I recommend reconstructing the abstract into 150 to 250 words that express crucial points, research implications, and detailed information to let readers understand your paper's essence. 4. The manuscript's subsection and structure need improvement to clearly and logically flow content. 5. Yes, the manuscript provides originality research with the highly desirable type of remote sensing research. 6. The references should be in a hanging indent format and need a better literature review to delimit the research problem and lead the reader to the study's objectives. 7. Clear all image resolutions and image recourses. 8. Some sentence contractions, such as it's (in abstract) may need to be more formal for the academic writing style. Consider replacing it with an uncontracted form and changing the verb form. 9. Detailed discussion is necessary, like the conclusion part. The discussion part is a curiosity. It would be best to use the literature to support and discuss your results. Contributions should be highlighted more. It should be made clear how it addresses the limitations of prior work. It should be made clear what is unknown and how it addresses the limitations of previous work.
