Please revise it. - The author in presenting the obtained results repeating the same sentences in all items, as he/she write a Theses, but not a scientific paper, subsequently, it needs to rewritten with suitable manner. - In addition, the author did not refer his results to any table, on one side, and on the other side, the author did not confirmed his written with the statistical analysis that was obtained. - The presented tables must be corrected and modified as shown in the corrected form, by adding: "±SE" after each mean value accompanied with its significant letter(s), F-values with its significant stats, P-values, and the footnote for each table. - References must be numbered and arranged them as they first appearance in the text, as the Journal Policy. In figure (1): The length (cm) and the weight (g) could be accepted as measures in one scale. It should be 2 scales: the 1st one for measuring the length (cm), while for measuring the weight (g). please correct the graph.
